## The Five Senses of Gingerbread

Discuss with your children the five senses. We use our five senses everyday. What do you see? Did you hear that? How did it taste? Can you smell that? What did you feel?

### Materials:

gingerbread man shapes  
chart paper

Bake gingerbread in the classroom and make this activity a great language opportunity. While the gingerbread is baking talk about the five senses. What do you smell? Let the children tell you what they smell. Write their responses on chart paper. What is happening while the gingerbread is baking? What do you see? How does it taste? Did you hear anything? How does it feel? After you have all of your responses on chart paper, create a class book. Let children decorate the pages with their own little gingerbread men.
