



How Many Letters in Your Name?

Materials:

- * Graph
- * Sticky note for each student

Can you spell your name? How many letters do you have in your name? Provide sticky notes for each student. Instruct them to write their name on the note. Discuss names and how many letters are in each name. Have students come one by one to the graph and place their sticky note on the correct number. For example, Bryan would put his name in the 5 column and Ashton would put her name in the 6 column. Ask questions

about the graph after all students' names have been placed. Who has the longest name? How many students have 4 letters in their name? Does anyone have 2 letters? Which column has the least amount of sticky notes?
