Frogs on a Log!

You will need:

Blue poster board

5 potato chip cans

15 small craft sticks

15 sheets frog small notepads

Make a pond with blue poster board. Make logs out of the potato chip cans by covering with brown construction paper or paint them brown. Make five slits on one side of the "log". Write a number on each log from 1 to 5. Glue frogs onto sticks. Students will enjoy counting frogs and placing them on the correct log.

Extension:

Roll a dice and decide if you should add more frogs to the log or subtract frogs from the log. The number of frogs on the log should always be the same as the number on the dice.
