## Candy Cane Cookies

Invite a parent to dress up as "Cathy Cook" in a baker's hat and apron and come to your classroom to make crispy "Candy Cane Cookies." Suggest they bring a large cookbook and a wooden spoon to complete the costume. Kids love to pretend!



1. Make up two batches of your favorite sugar cookie dough.
2. Color one batch with red food coloring and leave the other white.
3. Give each child one small ball of red dough and one small ball of white dough.
4. Show them how to roll each ball into a "snake."
5. Place the "snakes" side by side and twist together to form a striped candy cane shaped cookie.
6. Place on parchment paper and write the child's name next to his cookie.
7. Bake until done, but not brown. Do not over cook.
