Look inside my Apple!

Materials needed:

*Apples knife Paper plate scissors
Red, green & black washable paint*

Discuss with your children the inside of an apple. Cut an apple in half and share with the children. What did you find? How did the seeds get in the middle of the apple? Do the apples need seeds?

Your children will love making an apple core showing what's in their apple. Cut both sides of the paper plate with jagged scissors. Make it look like an hour glass. Paint both the top and bottom portion of the plate with your red paint, leaving the middle of the plate white. The extra pieces that were cut from the sides of the plate, paint green for the leaves of the apple. Have children dip their finger in the black paint and press on the plate in a triangle. These are apple seeds.

This is a great time to have a taste test and taste all the different kinds and colors of apples.
